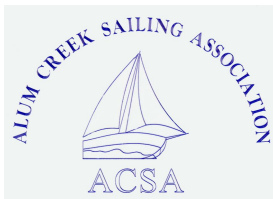
The course offers, 3 hours a week for 5 weeks of mostly on, and some off, the water instruction. You will sail on stable and well-maintained keelboats ranging from 22 to 26 feet in length. During the last week you are encouraged to take the 70 questions, multiple choice / true and false exam to obtain your certificate of completion card issued by the State of Ohio. As part of your prepaid enrollment fee, you will receive comprehensive study materials that will assist you in completing the exam. You can do it...don't worry!

After successfully completing our course you may want to crew with us during Wednesday night races; attend a club meeting to understand more about the activities and benefits; or buy a boat and secure a dock at our marina. Course Overview: Designed for the beginning adult (over 18) sailor. Covers basic sailing instruction, on and off the water. Topics include maneuvering and handling, boating safety, sail trim, engine management, casting off and docking, trailering, and monitoring of weather and conditions.
